THE STATES GENERAL OF THE GREEN ECONOMY 2017

THE IDEA

The States General of the Green Economy are a multi-stakeholder process, promoted by the Green Economy National Council, composed by 66 business organisations, in collaboration with the Ministry of Environment and the Ministry of Economic Development. The Sustainable Development Foundation is charged by the National Council to carry out the function of technical support of the initiative.

The aim is to develop, through a "participatory elaboration method", a programmatic platform able to promote a green economy in Italy through the analysis of positive potentials and obstacles, as well as policies and measures needed to improve the ecological quality of the strategic sectors.

The initiative takes place throughout the year thanks to the activity of 9 working groups, it ends with the final presentation of the outputs during an event that will last two days in Rimini, concurrently with Ecomondo, articulated in one plenary opening session, 5 parallel thematic session and one plenary closing session.



WORKING GROUPS 2017 of the Green Economy National Council

The Coordinators along with 350 experts participating to the working groups, write discuss and elaborate the documents for the consultation on the nine strategic themes and the policy proposal.

THE PARTECIPATIVE PROCESS INVOLVING THE STAKEHOLDERS TAKE PLACE THROUGH:

- The representative of companies and federations of companies working in the green economy, along with representatives of the civil society and the experts of the working groups.
- The convocation of national programmatic meetings opened to a wider public and various national events preparatory to the final event that will take place in Rimini in November.
- The confrontation between the working groups and the Directorates General of the relatives Ministries.
- A specific mailing list proposed by the National Council and the working groups.

NATIONAL PROGRAMMATIC MEETINGS

18 national programmatic events had been taking places between 2012 and 2016 with the aim of promoting a wider public discussion on the documents elaborated by the working groups. These documents represent the platform of programmatic and strategic proposal of the States General of the Green Economy.

The principal outputs of the VI edition of the States General of the Green Economy 2017 will be:

> THE THIRD RELATION ON THE STATES OF THE GREEN ECONOMY 2017

The 2017 relation, continuing the work started two years ago, wants to give an updated picture on the state of the green economy both at a national and international level touching the following themes: a focus on the green economy in the Italian cities, through a survey done by the Censis researchers, with the aim of observing the citizens consensus for specific green economy measure in their towns; the analysis of the strategic sectors of the Italian green economy; the state of the green economy in the future international scenarios analyzing the opportunities of the green companies with a specific focus on China, USA, Europe.

THE POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS DOCUMENT

These document contains the policy proposals of the Green Economy National Council, regarding the strategic sectors, these recommendations are directed to the institutional and political interlocutors in order to guide the decisions makers through a wider developing of the green economy.
